

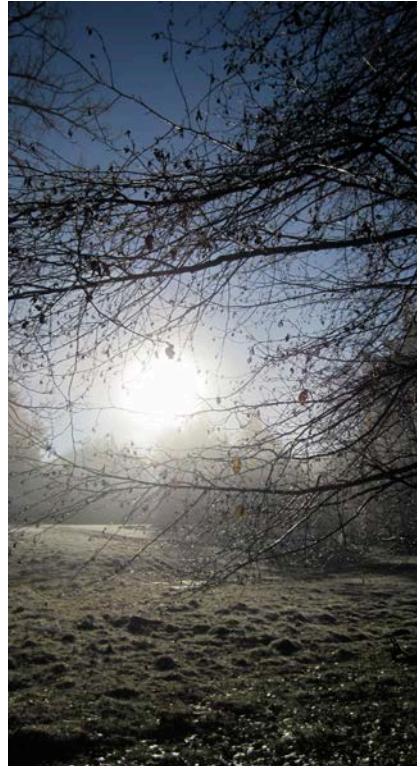

# Commemorative Conservation Grounds

**Our Commemorative Conservation Grounds** are part of O.U.R. ECOVILLAGE, a Demonstration Site and Education Centre on a 25-acre property in Shawnigan Lake dedicated to sustainable living. The Commemorative Conservation Grounds are located in our Woodland Conservation Sector, and are reserved for the scattering of cremated remains. Our Commemorative Conservation Grounds are one of the options available in the Protect O.U.R. ECOVILLAGE Forever campaign.

**All gifts to the Protect O.U.R. ECOVILLAGE Forever campaign** will be received by The Land Conservancy of BC and go towards the purchase of a conservation covenant to secure the unique land and values of O.U.R. ECOVILLAGE. As the conservation partner, TLC is responsible for the protective covenant. TLC will issue charitable tax receipts to donors.

**Our Offerings include** scattering of cremated remains over a chosen resting place in our Commemorative Conservation Grounds, as well as ceremonial services. Our services are intended to honor a wide variety of philosophical and spiritual traditions and embrace the unique wishes of individuals and their families to ensure a supportive, sacred and dignified transition.

**Making the choice to scatter cremation ashes on our grounds** is an environmentally sustainable way to commemorate one's life. Our Grounds provide a natural sanctuary for loved ones to rest and friends and family to visit. Choosing to return to the land means choosing sustainable well being for the land, ourselves, and our worldwide village. Together, we can make our final wishes become a lasting natural legacy for generations to come.
